Basing out of El Salvador!

I wanted to begin the fall newsletter with an overview and some testimonies from the last few months. Because so much has happened, i will just highlight a few of the major events. When we set out for El Salvador, Me and an assistant, left Ohio on August 16th. We drove for 6 days across the U.S. and Mexico into Central America. The Lord was with us on this drive. We had favor on every step of the trip, and even arrived into El Salvador a day and a half earlier than we expected. Gina and our daughters flew down on August 23rd.

Within the first few days we found our new house north of San Salvador. From that point on, we began to set up our office in SoyaPango, we preached in new churches, presented Crossfire to new Pastors and trained new leaders. On September 5th, we presented Crossfire to the directors of the Aisoy network of churches in

SoyaPango, and on Sept 12th we hosted a pastors dinner and Crossfire presentation to new pastors from San Salvador and SoyaPango in our new office.

Each week we are visiting a new church to implement Crossfire and train new leaders. We also preach and minister weekly in these new churches during their sunday services. We are visiting new Crossfire cell groups each week in neighborhoods across San Salvador. Praise God every week we are seeing new people accept Christ in the churches, and in these new cell groups.

We have trained more than 200 new Crossfire leaders and assistants, and some of the new churches that have joined Crossfire International include: La Vina de Soya Pango, La Iglesia Bautista de Soya Pango, tabrenacle de adoracion familiar, La Iglesia Oasis y Amor Assemblea de Dios, La Iglesia Meiz, El Shaddai, Iglesia Ebenezer, Iglesia Vision Celestial. New leaders have also been trained from the Aposento de JesuCristo network of churches,

as well, which are the the churches under our Crossfire El Salvador National Director, Pastor Solomon Gonzales.

We have also begun a monthly, Crossfire El Salvador leaders meeting. Each church sends the main leader of Crossfire from their church to these monthly leaders meetings, where we mentor these leaders, distribute the month's Crossfire lessons in Spanish for the cell groups, plan major upcoming events and pray together. Already, in the first few months, we are seeing significant growth in this meeting as new churches are joining Crossfire.

Crossfire El Salvador Crusades and Street Evangelism Oct 24-26

The Crossfire Crusades this fall were great successes! The crusade on Friday night took place in Santos Dos, SoyaPango, and the one on Saturday night was in Las Margaritas, SoyaPango. On the third day, we ended with a Crossfire Sunday in Aposento de JesuCristo church in Santos Dos. This year, we had teams of the Crossfire leaders meet three hours before the nightly crusades both days and go out into the streets of SoyaPango to evangelize. These areas are very dangerous, they are controlled by two rival gangs MS-13 and Calle-18. Many of the youth who live in these gang controlled areas are beaten, and can even be killed by the gangs in their neighborhood if they cross into the other rival gang area without permission.

Both days during the street evangelism, we shared Christ with people on the streets as well as knocked on doors. Praise God! During this outreach, many people accepted Christ, including two MS-13 gang members and a prostitute.

The crusades both nights featured a dance team, dramas from the new Crossfire El Salvador Drama Team, and worship from the newly formed Crossfire El Salvador Worship Team. Pastor Joe preached

a message called "Decisiones" on Friday and "No mires afuera de la ventana" on Saturday. On Sunday we led the first ever Crossfire youth and young adult Sunday in Aposento de Jesucristo Church, and we taught their Crossfire leaders how to lead their own Crossfire Sundays. All three services resulted in powerful ministry times with the alters full of people accepting Christ,

rededicating their lives to Christ, and being touched by the power of the Holy Spirit.

We have a few more events this November, and at the end of November, we return to the U.S. to meet with our board of directors, preach and share testimonies in several partnering churches, and visit friends and family for Thanksgiving and Christmas. In early January, we will return to El Salvador for another year of adventure!


