The site features a 'Select Language' option, at the top right, that allows it to be seen in over 80 languages. Expansion into Venezuela

As many of you know one of our goals in relocating to El Salvador is to expand the work of Crossfire International across Central America and into South America. We have been praying about what countries in South America to visit first, as well as asking God for the right connections in South America.

In August of 2008, I, Gina, and a team of our Crossfire leaders from the U.S. traveled to

Hyderabad, India to lead an evangelistic crusade, and train Crossfire India cell group leaders.

On our way to India, we spent the night in Frankfurt Germany. While we were visiting the city of Frankfurt, we randomly met a team of Venezuelan missionaries who were ministering in the streets. The leader of this Venezuelan team prophesied to me and the Crossfire team in Spanish about the mission to India, and we exchanged contact information. During the mission trip in India, i lost their contact information.

Last December of 2013, i got an email from Engly Gabriel Alfonso Oviedo, who was a part of this Venezuelan mission team we had met in Germany in 2008. He told me that he had lost my card and found it 5 and 1/2 years later in December when he contacted me. He said that God put it on his heart that it was time for him to work with Crossfire International. He had no idea about our relocation to to El Salvador, and he had no idea that we had been praying about expanding into South America. We communicated and prayed for three months, then we trained Engly. Last week Engly became the first leader of Crossfire in Venezuela and in South America.

Engly is going to connect us with new churches in Venezuela, and we are making plans for a trip from El Salvador to Venezuela, Peru and Columbia next Spring of 2015.



Crossfire International El Salvador Transition Update

We are still in the middle of the transition process and wanted to update everyone on how

everything is going. For those who have not yet heard, we had our second daughter, Sara Elise Dewhurst on, February 21st, at 9:58 p.m., weighing 7 pounds and 1 ounce!

We are now just over 4 months away from the time we will be relocating our base of operations to El Salvador. Our plan is for me and an assistant to leave August 16th from Ohio, and drive for 8 days to San Salvador, El Salvador. Gina, a Crossfire leader, and our two daughters, will fly down and meet us there.

We have been working through an extensive list of things that must be done before we leave. We are also putting together the major events and mission trips that will take place this fall, and in the spring of 2015. We are also continuing to build new partnerships by meeting with pastors, speaking in churches, and meeting with individuals. Our goal is, by the time we leave, to have enough commitments to reach our monthly operational budget and raise the funds needed for the transition to El Salvador. We are diligently working to secure support, so that we can fully focus on the work of the ministry while we are in El Salvador.

For those of you who are in the U.S., we will have our send off event, Fri night, May 9th at 7:00 p.m., at Crossroads church 11573 Lithopolis rd N.W. Lithopolis Oh 43136. Please come out! We will have dinner and fellowship, I will share the vision and goals of this transition, and there will be a time of corporate prayer!
