## **Crossfire International "What** will you choose?" Camps 2015

We wanted to begin this newsletter with some exciting testimonies from this year's, 'What will you choose?', spring and summer camps that have taken place around the world. Along with our regular annual camps, there were new Crossfire camps started this April in three different nations.

The first camp of the year was the Crossfire Thailand Karen tribal camp held in March. The Karen tribal people live in the mountains of Southern Thailand near Myanmar. Pastor Apichat and the Crossfire Thailand team directed this camp, and praise God over 300 youth and young adults gave their lives to Christ.

In April, we directed several camps. The first camp was with Crossfire Cambodia and took place in the Banteay Menchay Provence of Western Cambodia. This was our first camp in

Cambodia, and was led by Petros Kong (Crossfire Cambodia National Director) and a mission team of leaders from Crossfire Thailand.

The second camp in April was the Crossfire El Salvador camp held at Campamento Genesaret in Lago Ilopango, and this was the first Crossfire camp in El Salvador! This camp brought together youth and young adults from new churches who are a part of Crossfire across several states of El Salvador. At this camp, the newly formed Crossfire El Salvador worship team

Burma (Myanmar). At the end of April, our Crossfire Thailand team traveled to Burma to direct this camp. This camp was started for the churches that we implemented Crossfire in during our 2013 mission to South East Asia.

Praise God during these first camps of 2015 we have already seen over 600 youth and young adults accept Christ, and hundreds set free and filled with the Holy Spirit and trained to be Crossfire leaders in their churches.

# Crossfire International Spring 2015 Mission Trips

The first two Crossfire mission trips this spring were the Crossfire Thailand missions to Cambodia and Burma in April to direct the first Crossfire camps in these two countries. These teams were led by Pastor Apichat (our Thailand national director). Several young adults who are leaders in Crossfire Thailand had the opportunity to go on their first international mission

trips. These mission teams preached the messages, led worship, directed the games, trained new leaders, and taught the leaders of Crossfire Cambodia and Burma how to lead their own camps.

Our next mission trip this spring was to Choluteca, Honduras and Managua, Nicaragua from El Salvador. This mission was led by Pastor Joe and Pastor Solomon (National Director in El Salvador). During this trip, Pastor Joe and Pastor Solomon presented Crossfire to new networks of churches, implemented Crossfire in several of these churches, and preached in some of their services. Plans were made to return to Honduras and Nicaragua this September to lead

evangelistic crusades, train more leaders and implement Crossfire in more churches.

The final Crossfire mission trip this spring was from Mindanao island to Camigan Island in the Philippines. This mission was led by Larachel and a team of Crossfire Philippines leaders. This team implemented Crossfire in new churches, trained new leaders, and started new cell groups. They also led several youth and young adults to Christ during the evangelistic outreaches, and held a special baptism service in a river in Camigan Island.
